They may be living alone, homeless, living with family or in a home or facility. Maybe they are recovering from a trauma or illness or feeling lonely or alone after experiencing a recent loss in their life. Some may be weakened in spirit or body. Some may be starting a new phase of life.

The common thread that connects all these people is that they are adults in need of a little bit of joy in their lives.

About JoyCatchers

Since 2006, JoyCatchers volunteers have helped adults to 'catch joy' by decorating and bringing into their lives individually decorated, tabletop size artificial holiday trees. Most are delivered trimmed and ready to be enjoyed. Many are delivered to non-profits as a Tree Trim Activity for their seniors or veterans to decorate trees as a group activity or Community Service Project.

What began as a simple idea combining tree trimming with thinking of others at what can be for some a particularly lonely time of year, the JoyCatchers Tree Project has grown from the 35 trees in 2006 to 950 trees donated in 2018. The goal for 2019 is 950 trees. Since its inception, 6,080 decorated trees have been donated through the efforts of generous and caring people bringing joy to adults...one tree at a time.
